Notes for users of After Effects CC, released June 2013

Below is a list of changes to the instructions in *After Effects Apprentice 3rd Edition* for the lessons to work correctly in After Effects CC:

Pre-Roll

page 6:

The Live Update button has been removed from the Timeline panel.

pages 12–13:

Adobe Bridge is no longer installed along with After Effects. Make sure you use the Adobe Application Manager to also download and install Bridge.

pages 44–45:

The default graph type is now Value Graph, not Auto-Select. As before, After Effects will remember any changes you make to the Choose Graph Type and Options menu for each composition.
